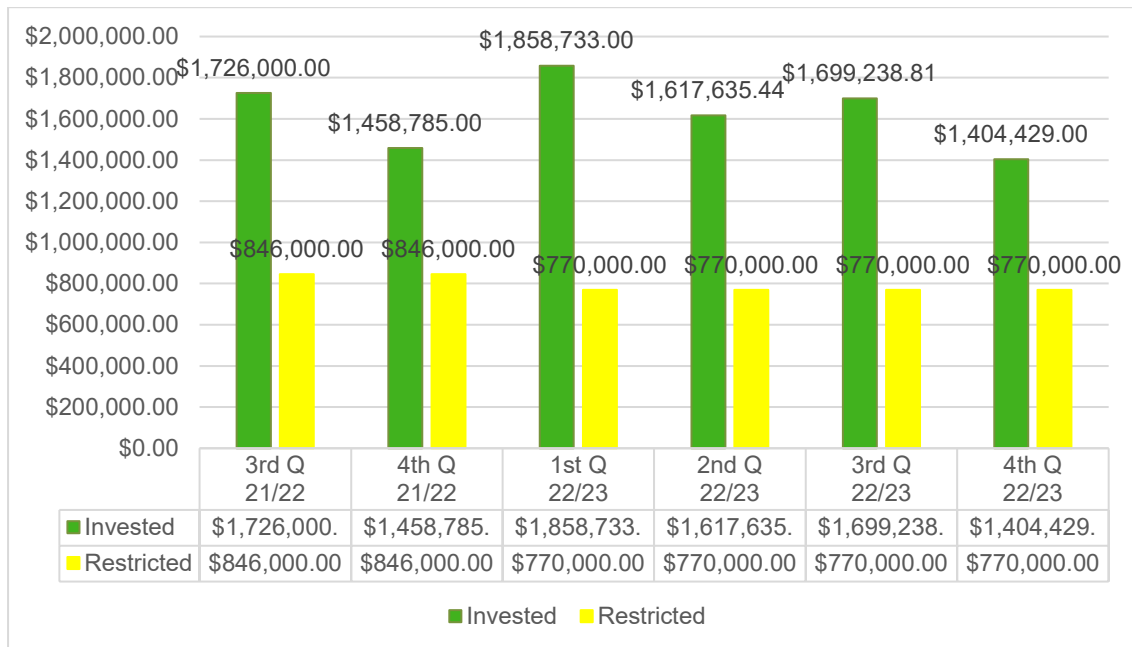

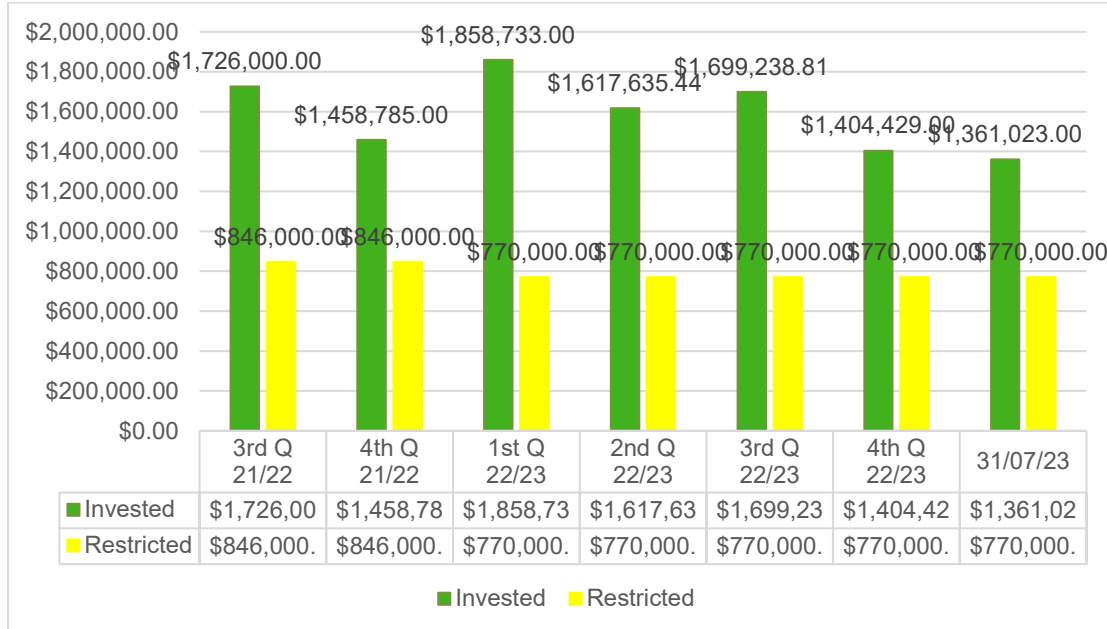

Annual roadside spraying is moving to the new 3-year rotation program starting this spraying season 2023-2024. This new program, adopted by council, will ensure every road within the four constituent council areas of Bathurst, Blayney, Lithgow and Oberon will be treated for weed control every 3 years. This will satisfy the biosecurity duty of each council under the Biosecurity Act 2015. Following an extensive process, the roads have now been divided into their three sections for each of the four constituent council areas.
